What you can expect in every classroom

Responsibilities:

Teachers: To provide a positive and safe environment for pupils to learn

Pupils: To work with staff and other pupils in a respectful way by following staff instructions, participating in lessons and following the Toynbee School Student Charter

Below is the chain of events that will happen if pupils do not fulfil their responsibilities as outlined in the Toynbee School Student Charter

1st Warning

2nd Warning

3rd Warning

Sent to work in a Buddy Room

Sanction & Restorative Meeting with the Teacher

8888 called & taken to another Room

Sanction & Restorative Meeting

HOD/GM will be informed

Persistent Disruption or Defiance

(Subsequent 8888 calls in future lessons)

Further Sanction & Restorative Meeting

Behaviour Plan Agreed by Teacher/HOD/GM

8888 will always be called if a Pupil:

- **Uses verbally abusive or discriminatory language**
- **Acts in an aggressive or intimidatory way towards any member of the school community**
- **Acts in an unsafe manner or puts the safety of others at risk**

The incident will be referred to the GM, PD or Senior Leadership Team
