PE lessons

The first time they do not have the correct kit results in a phone call home, second a break/lunch detention, the third time results in an after school detention and a phone call home. These are reset for each term. If a pupil is to be excused due to illness or injury, please supply a note/email with explaining the reason and a date of expected return. An excused student will still need their kit to change into, this makes them look and feel like a part of the lesson and should the lesson be outside and it rain or they get wet or muddy they have a clean uniform to change into. For long term illness or injury, the student welfare officer should also be informed.
