Updated guidance on face coverings in School

Firstly, can I thank you for your help during what has been a difficult time. Our pupils have supported the school and each other by being sensible, keeping safe and wearing a face covering. As we start to get back to normal, the government has begun to lift restrictions. I hope we will continue in this way and not have to return to face coverings in school or in the worst case back to lock down and school closure. It is of course up to us all to be sensible, continue to distance, and still observe hygiene rules. From 17 May, in line with Step 3 of the roadmap, face coverings will no longer be recommended for pupils and students in classrooms or communal areas, in all schools and further education providers. However if your child feels more comfortable wearing a mask, they may continue to do so - it is entirely your decision. Face coverings will also no longer be recommended for staff in classrooms. I have attached the full guidance from the DfE for information.
